How can you help?

Everybody coming in has a copy of the Race Card with your race printed on it, the MC announces the Race, and people are encouraged to support business sponsors (we can add your phone number). Our last fundraising event was attended by over 600 local people. There are only 8 races to be sponsored. COST £20 + Free admission for two.

2) Buy a horse: make up a name and then have the owners name printed after it e.g. 3. MOTHERS PRIDEMs. B.Hourigan
COST £5 but each race will have a winning owners prize of £10 !

3) Come to the Race Night. Everybody who has been to them in the past says it's a great nights entertainment. Admission £2

Its legal and fun. We will be showing eight films of horse races each with eight runners. Each film is sealed so that nobody knows which horse will win. A film is chosen by one of the audience after the betting is completed. Betting is simple, people buy tickets for a particular horse, the holders of the winning tickets take equal shares of a proportion of the takings (a smaller part is for the Association).
