(i) Statutory Bodies

a) London Borough Grants Scheme - New round begins in Autumn. Two things appealed to LBGS. Firstly, two boroughs are covered and secondly, the Irish Ethnic Interest. In our application we must emphasise constituency and the lack of existing provision.

LBGS said not to do feasibility study - emphasise initiative from within the community. Demonstrate commitment through effectiveness of our application. Average size of grant £5-7,000. Have funded projects to the tune of £30-40,000. We should be looking at higher rate of grants.

Emphasise track record of individuals.

LBGS gave a grant of £90,00 to Willesden Green Centre/Saddlers Wells for a joint project - so they have money to give.

We have to apply around Autumn. We need to keep in touch with LBGS, and to demonstrate how well organised we are we should SEND THEM A PACKAGE with
