The London Irish Youth Forum (LIYF) brings together on a bi-monthly basis workers from both voluntary and statutory organisations. It provides the opportunity to exchange information and expertise on issues affecting emigrant Irish youth in London and serves a strategic role in identifying changing needs and emerging trends relating to their welfare.

The Forum also aims to assist and support London welfare and accommodation agencies in their response to the needs of emigrant Irish youth and identify resources required to meet these needs.

The AGIY workers service the Forum and pursue issues of concern that arise from the Forum meetings with the appropriate authorities.

Issues addressed in the past have included HIV+ and AIDS amongst young Irish drug users in London, needs of Irish women in London, health and safety on building sites, poll tax and its implications, issues and concerns affecting travellers, YTS legislation and implications of young Irish people ...
