The Forum is serviced by the Action Group for Irish Youth (AGIY) and meets on a bi-monthly basis. Sharing information and pooling expertise on a range of issues affecting the welfare of young Irish emigrants, the Forum serves a strategic role in identifying the changing patterns of need relating to the continuing high numbers of young Irish people in London.

*The Forum is open to workers from both statutory and voluntary bodies. Issues of concern include the development of information resources for young Irish people new to London, the promotion of an Irish dimension within equal opportunity programmes and the implications for Irish people of legislative change with particular regard to social security, housing and employment and training.*
