It's 1944 in rural Ireland. On the first Friday of every month all the women of the village leave behind their families and chores, get on their bicycles and ride up to 'Maiden's Hill'. It is the place where their own Mothers, Grandmothers and even their Great Grandmothers came and gathered before them, going back years, even before the famine times.... Maiden's Hill is a place full of resonance, where these women's connection with their ancestors is strongly felt.

Up on Maiden's Hill, in the presence of the spirits of those who have been there before them, the powerful, poignant stories of the lives of these Irish Women unfold.

The Irish Women's Theatre Workshop is a new Irish Community Based Theatre Workshop, jointly supported by Arts Ireland / The Hammersmith & Fulham Irish Centre and The Riverside Studios.

Ideas for the play 'Upon Maiden's Hill' have been explored by local Irish women, living and working in the Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham.
