

SUGGESTIONS AS TO ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE ANTI-PARTITION

BY THE ANTI-PARTITION OF IRELAND LEAGUE

As the League is organised Nationally, Regionally, and Locally the activities will naturally fall into three groups. The following are considered to be appropriate groupings:-

National Executive

- 1) Publications : The Nat. Executive should undertake the publication of suitable pamphlets and leaflets for distribution throughout the country. e.g. Report of Special Powers Act by Nat. Council for Civil Liberties .  
(2) The Last Quarrel- Hugh Delargy (Published by Irish Anti-Partition League, Manchester)  
These should be brief, comprehensive, and low in price.
- 2) MANIFESTO to - All M.P's  
All members of House of Lords  
All Mayors and Town Clerks.  
Chairmen of Borough Conservative, Liberal and Labour Parties etc  
This manifesto would need to be very carefully drawn up and distributed to everybody simultaneously
- 3) Lobbying of M.P.'s and private approach to same when matters pertaining to Ireland are due for discussion (e.g. N. Ireland estimates)
- 4) Deputations to Home Secy., Dominions Secy. etc on specific questions relating to Partition (e.g. wholesale arrests in Six Counties last Dec., Conscription in Six Counties)
- 5) Organise a National Petition for formal presentation to Prime Minister etc.
- 6) Investigate the possible employment of Publicity Agencies.
- 7) Cultivate the co-operation of influential bodies like the National Council for Civil Liberties, London.
- 8) National Appeal for Funds.

REGIONAL COMMITTEES

- 1) Lectures to Political, Social, Literary, and Religious bodies.
- 2) Press correspondence and arranged articles.
- 3) Demonstrations.
- 4) Use of Hoardings to convey brief but sensible points with a view to making the Public conscious of the problem.
- 5) Formation of branches.

BRANCH COMMITTEES.

- 1) ORGANISE PUBLIC MTGS AND LECTURES as (1) above.
- 2) Approach and inform local public representatives
- 3) Local Press - letters & articles.
- 4) Distribution and sale of literature.
- 5) Increase membership
