Memorandum to Branch Secretaries.

At its meeting on Thursday June 8th, the Provisional Council of the Anti-Partition of Ireland League (London area) discussed a proposal to reduce the membership fee of the League from 2/6 to 1/ per annum.

This proposal was agreed to unanimously. Existing members who have paid a subscription of 2/6 are reminded that the membership fee is still a minimum fee of 1/.

The financial position of the League is still insecure. To make itself a powerful Organisation the League must first become self-supporting and for this reason it is important that the recruiting of members be continued with vigour and enthusiasm. There is now no barrier to membership from the point of view of wealth and every branch will be expected to increase its members substantially under the reduced membership fee. The members of each branch are expected to do their share.
