Report of A Committee Meeting

The Committee discussed the Report of the Provisional Council's decisions, read by the Secretary. Arising from the section of the Report dealing with the obtaining of names for the Appeal for funds, a few names were available but it was urged that members should let the Secy. have names by letter or at the next Branch Meeting. The choice of a Delegate fell on Mr. R. Gillis. An Entertainment Committee of 5 was elected. In addition to the usual items Mr. Cahill proposed the insertion in the Branch meeting agenda of the following motion "that this meeting deplores the adoption by the Provisional Council of the title "Anti-Partition of Ireland League" and suggests the adoption, in place of the present negative title, of a positive title such as "The United Ireland League". Mr. Gillis seconded. Mr. Gillis proposed that the Branch should be asked to discuss the question of

a monthly subscription by members. Mrs. Donnelly Wood seconded. The next Branch meeting was fixed for 23.5.39 at Osdridge Rd. School. The Secy. was instructed to convene a meeting of the Entertainments Cttee. and arrange with the Treasurer for the payment of requisite newspapers etc.
