

ACTION POINTS FROM EXECUTIVE MEETING OF 22 FEBRUARY
1992

- * Jonathan to draw up draft "contract" between Executive/IRISH STUDIES REVIEW editorial group.
- * Jim McA to present paper on a regional strategy for next meeting of Officers; to explore possibility of setting up a Northern BAIS Seminar Group.
- * Jonathan to organise an initial meeting of a London seminar.
- * Bob Bell and Joe Sheeran to be invited to next Officers' meeting.
- * Seán to talk to Joe Sheeran; ask him to produce half-page on feasible strategy for schools.
- * David to send copy of original entries of non-repliers to SURVEY to office with text of covering letter; Polly M to send out.
- * Debate on alternative strategies to take place at next Executive on 25 April; papers submitted to the Office by 14 April would be circulated from the Office.
- * David to contact Michael Bromley to see if he would assist Association with PR. Ask him to talk to Seán.
- * Jonathan to convene subcommittee to discuss format for 1993 Conference.
- * Executive to see draft of brochure on Irish Studies in higher education; this to be distributed June/July.
- * George Boyce to be invited to next Officers' meeting to discuss the situation in higher education.
- * Irish language examinations with IOL: paper to be presented to next Executive re issues around Institute's request for sponsorship.
- * Seán to write to Patrick Buckland asking for a report on the JEP, to form part of a wind-up report on sponsorship to AIB Bank; to inquire re the publications made drawn up under the JEP and their availability to BAIS for distribution outside the Northe-West.
