

VOLUNTEER MENTOR ROLE DESCRIPTION



All mentors will be asked to undertake the following once accepted onto the project;

- 1. To undertake initial and ongoing training as required.
- 2. To attend regular support groups and supervision meetings.
- 3. To attend project events/ activities (i.e. an adventure away day with mentees).
- 4. To meet with mentee on a weekly basis, in a one to one situation for a period of 6 months to one year.
- 5. To ensure that a positive, supportive mentoring relationship is created between the mentee and mentor.
- 6. To support and motivate the mentee in developing skills which will assist them in achieving and sustaining their personal goals.
- 7. To fully complete monitoring and review sheets as requested.
- 8. To inform Mentoring workers of any concerns that they have regarding their mentoring relationship.
- 9. To work in accordance with Bias's Code of Practice.
- 10. To work in accordance and maintain Bias's principles of Confidentiality.
- 11. To work in accordance with Bias's Equal Opportunities Policy.
- 12. To work in accordance with Bias's Health and Safety regulations.
- 13. To give signed consent to be part of the evaluation process.
