Housing. We provide housing information and support to Irish people in housing need.

Social Work. We assist Irish people to obtain the welfare services and benefits they are entitled to.

Young People. Drop-in facilities for young Irish people both newly arrived and settled. A young mother's group meets regularly.

Established in 1978, Brent Irish Advisory Service provides information and community services to all Irish in London, and especially the Brent part of North West London.


BIAS' work is carried out by staff and volunteers who all share a common concern for the Irish in London.
