

"ON THE SITES"

A Photographic Exhibition by David Hevey

"On the Sites" The Irish Construction Safety Exhibition aims to illustrate the dangers faced by workers on British building sites, where on average, three workers are killed each week and a death or serious injury occurs every hour of the working day.

It focuses on the experience of young Irish people entering the industry but is of relevance to all building workers and those concerned with the issue of death and injury on the buildings.

The exhibition consists of 20 laminated panels containing scenes from the building industry and personal statements from injured workers and relatives of those who have died. It shows the de-regulated nature of the industry, sub-contracting and how the growth of the lump have increased the dangers on sites. It highlights the fear of victimisation felt by casual workers.

The exhibition is available for hire to local authorities, welfare bodies, campaigning groups and voluntary organisations.

The exhibition was commissioned by The Action Group for Irish Youth, The Connolly Association and the Construction Safety Campaign.

There is a minimum charge of £20 per day. The price does not include transport or a supporting stand. Hire charges are based on a sliding scale according to the nature of the organisation and the length of time the exhibition is required for.
