

LEITRIM ASSOCIATION IN LONDON MEETING, 52 CAMDEN SQUARE, LONDON NW1.

There was a meeting of the Leitrim Association in London at the Irish Centre, 52, Camden Square, London NW1, on 17th November 1980. Present were Michael Mulvannerty, John McGarry, Nora McGreal, Michael Winters (Chairman), Doris Daly and Father Butler.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted. Proposed for adoption by Michael Mulvannerty and seconded by John McGarry.

From the minutes it was pointed out that Mr Kilelea was a representative of Irish Life Assurance....that Michael Winters was looking after the menus... that the 1979 London Irish Festival medals were available but that the 1980 London Irish Festival medals should be queried....the Leitrim Association in London did not agree to subsidize the Council of Irish Counties Dinner Dance....that a remittance be sent to the Leitrim Guardian for the outstanding account at the rate of 80p per copy (proposed Michael Mulvannerty and seconded John McGarry).

POINTS FROM THE AGENDA. There should be a presentation of bouquets of flowers to the principal guest ladies at the dinner dance....that arrangements be made for flowers for the table...that the tables be numbered and that the names of the patrons be put on an alphabetical chart with table numbers away from the door for convenience...that an autographed football from Arsenal be auctioned at the Dinner Dance....that the Leitrim County Development team would visit for the March function.

It was agreed to hold informal meetings before the dinner dance to discuss arrangements for the function only. And the next meeting to be on 24th November.
