Membership of the League is open to all persons, whatever their political convictions, who are convinced that Ireland's claim to unity is just and reasonable, and who are ready to work in a constitutional, democratic, and legal way for the removal of the artificial frontier between Irish people in their own homeland. The League is entirely independent and non-sectarian and is unique in that it welcomes also the support of British people of good will and honest pur ose who see in the natural aspirations of the Irish people for unity a factor for peace between two old and historic nations.
