At the meeting of the Provisional Council of the Anti-Partition of Ireland League on Friday last, April 21st, it was suggested that an approach be made to you with a view to

- (a) Securing a full page advertisement, either front or back, inside or outside, in the programme issued by your Association for the Whit Monday fixture;
- (b) Allowing us to insert a loose leaflet in your programme for Whit Monday if an advertisement is not possible;
- (c) Securing your permission to allow our Organisation to distribute leaflets outside all the exit gates of the Stadium.

If you can see your way to grant us permission to insert an advertisement in your programme for Whit Monday I should be glad if you could inform me of the rate, approximate circulation, and latest date for receiving advertisement copy etc.

In common with the rest of the Council, I feel that you will be willing to grant us these facilities in order that we may have an opportunity to enlist the support of Irish people for our movement.
