I am sorry to trouble you again but there seems to be some mix up about the issuing of receipts from your district. As you know the Council decided at its last meeting that all moneys should be forwarded direct from branches to the Central Office. That has not yet been done in Highgate and the result is that some of the people who paid their fees at the first or second Highgate meeting have not been issued with receipts from this Office.
