

It may interest you to know that the request for a guarantee of £200 from the Anti-Partition Committee in Dublin was agreed to and the money has been lodged to the credit of a separate account in London.

The Branches in London are working smoothly and there are very good prospects of establishing some more within the next few weeks. One of our Branches (Stepney) is holding a public meeting on its own next Thursday which will, we hope, attract some publicity. I enclose a handbill for your attention.
