Dear Mr Hickey,

I have to acknowledge, with thanks, your letter dated the 17th instant, together with cheque for £12 on account of salary and expenses, and have pleasure in enclosing herewith receipt for same. I note that the question of a definite salary will be dealt with by the Provisional National Executive at its next meeting, and feel that a decision by that body would be the most satisfactory way of settling the matter.

With regard to the amount of £3 suggested by Liverpool, we fully endorse your view that this rate is unduly low and I can assure you that it was not from a sense of modesty that we put forward that figure but rather ~~that~~ we were anxious that a reasonable margin should be left available for expenses - for the present at any rate.

I am completing arrangements for making the necessary contact with certain people in Liverpool and district with a view to getting at least half a dozen branches going in this area. I am also in touch with Wigan with a view to arranging a meeting with certain people there and hope to be able to report progress to the next meeting of the Executive. A certain amount of preliminary work will of course be necessary and as there is only an interval of a fortnight to the next meeting of the Executive I do not anticipate that we will be able to report anything in the nature of extensive progress. At any rate a commencement of operations is some satisfaction.
