Dear

For the past sixteen years the problem of the 'Border' has seemed to be well-nigh unapproachable. During that time 400,000 of our people have been enduring an undisguised tyranny, which tends to intensify rather than abate. Every vestige of liberty has been stripped from the unhappy minority in the Six-County area—the franchise (local and parliamentary), the right of assembly or opposition to the party in power, free speech, the inviolability of the person, the right to public trial after arrest, and even the right to earn a living. Can we longer remain unmoved and inactive?

There are evidences that the temper of responsible authorities has undergone some change of late, and it is conceivable that persistent condemnation and broadcasting of the facts will dispose the British Government to take action in the matter. Their interests lie manifestly in the direction of a settlement.

To this end the Anti-Partition League anticipates the whole-hearted support of the Irish people of this area. Not all can be openly active, but in diverse ways all can help.

There is immediate need for substantial funds to launch and maintain the campaign. The Committee solicit donations on a generous scale and trust that those to whom this appeal is addressed will feel priviliged to play a part in removing the last obstacle to Irish freedom. Let our efforts be commensurate with the importance of the undertaking.
