I had a letter this morning from Dublin and I saw from it that the Connolly Club had asked Councillor Delargy to speak at their proposed meeting on March 19th. This meeting, as a matter of fact was called off in the last few days.

As you probably know our big meeting is coming off on March 28th. All the speakers have not yet been decided upon, but it was the intention of the Council to have a representative from one of the Branches in Manchester or Liverpool. The Council will be meeting this week and I think it is fairly certain that an invitation will be issued to Councillor Delargy to come down and speak for us. I shall of course let you know officially in a few days, but I mention the matter now as I had a talk with the Hon. Secretary and a few members of the Council about it already.

Thank you also for a copy of the leaflet which you forwarded; we shall be getting out something on the same lines for distribution on St. Patrick's Day.

The question of having a conference between delegates representing the League in London, Limerpool, Manchester and Glasgow is also being considered by our Council this week. One suggestion for the venue was Manchester but it has also been suggested that the conference might be held here in London on Sunday, March 26th., the

Sunday prior to our meeting. A representative from the Council in Dublin would also attend. The representation from each centre has yet to be decided on, I wonder if you would let me know as soon possible how London would suit you as a venue.
