

I have today received written confirmation of the Fianna Fail Anti-Partition Committee's agreement to the request for a financial guarantee of £200 towards meeting the salaries of Organisers in the Manchester and Liverpool Zones. A draft for the amount mentioned is now in my possession and will be lodged to the credit of an account which I shall open immediately with the National Bank in the joint names of the Hon. Treasurers and Hon. Secretary.

The Anti-Partition Committee (Dublin) express the opinion that the respective Organisers should start work in their respective <sup>20</sup>ones without delay, but before any payments can be made from the Provisional National Executive's account I shall have to acquaint the Chairman and the Joint Hon. Treasurers with the salaries which the Manchester and Liverpool Councils propose should be paid to the Organisers in their respective Zones. I would ask you to let



me know at your earliest convenience of the Manchester Council's decision in this matter.
